The sayed Mris Woodward and Mr Busby by lease against the south, Philpott lane and the sayed Mr. Busby by lease against the East, as more plainely appeareth by this Plott ffollowing.

One other Chamber adioyning Cont from south to North besydes the Chimney 8 foote <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> & from East to West 21 foote <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> The ffyft Story

A faire Garrett ouer all Cont: from East to West 22 foote 3 inches, and from north to south 30 foote. Two Sellers vnder all Cont: from East to West 17 foote 8 inches, and from north to south 26 foote.

A Garrett ouer the Chamber aforesayed Cont: in Length besydes the passage into the same 16 foote  $\frac{1}{2}$  and in bredth 13 footte
